### **Job description**

Stone Sawyer

Reporting to the Masonry Manager and forming part of highly focussed Production Team the successful candidate must have experience in a masonry environment. The person will ideally have a proven work history operating primary and secondary saws and be competent to load and unload tables with forklifts and cranes. Cut stone must be produced to the highest quality and efficiency and suitably protected / packed for any post processes.

The person must understand and adopt all health, safety, and environmental practises and able to identify, manage and mitigate risks and contribute effectively so that the overall operation runs efficiently, seamlessly, and safely.

The role will suit an initiative-taking and flexible sawyer / operator with a strong work ethic that wants to work as part of a team.

### **Roles and responsibilities**

- Operating primary and secondary stone saws to the highest standard, safety, and efficiency.
- Operating lifting equipment e.g. cranes and forklift trucks
- Making sure that cut stone is produced correctly, and if required: - packaged, labelled, and transported safely.
- Completing inspections of plant / equipment and supplying paperwork to the manager or office.
- Raising any HSE concerns to your line manager or management team.
- Any other tasks as requested by your line manager.
